GENTLE REMINDER ON PUNCTUALITY AND SCHOOL ATTIRE

2. **Punctuality:** All students are expected to be in school **by 7.25 a.m.** for our flag raising assembly. Being punctual to school demonstrates personal responsibility and serves as a good start to the day. We have noticed that there is a group of students who still enter the school only after 7.25am. While we have spoken to students on the importance of punctuality, we seek the help of parents in reinforcing this message.

While the school will provide biscuits in such cases to ensure no child goes hungry during recess, we seek your cooperation in preventing such situations. For students under the Financial Assistance Scheme (FAS), please ensure your child brings his/her Student Pass to school daily, as this is required for purchasing food and drinks during recess.
